NEW YORK STATE EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM

Project: IBM Power Systems — 780 Server Suite with AIX Operating System, Tivoli Storage Management, and implementation engineering for the Department of Health Bureau of Early Intervention

Description: To provide disaster recovery alternate site capability that will be able to assume New York Early Intervention System (NYEIS) processing within 2-4 days of a catastrophic event that renders the NYS State Data Center inoperable. NYEIS is a centralized, Web-based, state-of-the-art system that electronically manages Early Intervention Program (EIP) administrative tasks and provides for information exchanges. This system is designed to support EIP's service delivery, financial, administration, and management activities at both the local and state levels.

Est. Total Cost: \$1,000,000.00

Amt of ARRA Funds: \$500,000.00

Project: IBM Power 520 Server for New York Early Intervention System (NYEIS)

Description: Server to house the NYEIS application for Early Intervention Program support staff training purposes.

Est. Total Cost: \$2,840.43

Amt of ARRA Funds: \$32,840.43

Project: Dell Disk Array - Disk attachment for the Early Intervention Fiscal System

Description: To increase server space in order to continue to operate until all data is migrated into NYEIS.

Project: Dell Server for Bureau of Early Intervention Systems Development

Description: Server to house the Microsoft SharePoint software and the Microsoft SQL Server Relational Database Management System used to develop and customize the NYEIS Helpdesk System.

Project: Cybernetics Disk to Disk to Tape Library for Orleans County

Description: Backup of NYEIS data for long term storage.

Est. Total Cost: \$10,000

Project: Hewlett Packard Server for Orleans County

Description: Dedicated domain controller for authenticating NYEIS computers on the network.

Est. Total Cost: \$5,000

Description: File and print server needed to replace current server that is at the end of its useful life.

Est. Total Cost: \$8,000
